Basketball club Petrovgrad was founded on 2007 in Zrenjanin, Serbia, as a mini basket club. Goal of the club founder, Stanoje Novaković, was to develop love for sports and competition in children, providing their healthier future.

At first the club counted around twenty children, age from 5 – 8, and the trainings had been held in court of primary school "Dositej Obradović". By 2011 the club has counted more than 50 children age 5 – 15 in three competing teams.

Club founded senior team in 2012 and qualified directly to second regional league, with losing a single game in the 2012 summer league.

Today club counts more than 100 members in six competing selections, while its showcase includes three third places, five second, and one championship for youth players in official national league.

Petrovgrad was participant in dozen international tournaments. We believe that basketball provides beautiful ways for children to meet new friends and compete with each other, and that the best way to expand your knowledge is to share it with friends. Because of such beliefs, Petrovgrad aims to develop Christmas tournament in Zrenjanin, since 2014.

Short history of Serbia

Serbia, of officially Republic of Serbia, is continental country mostly located in the southeastern Europe, on the Balkan Peninsula, with the northern part of the country located in central Europe (Pannonian lowlands). Belgrade is Serbian capital and home to more than two million people. It is administrative and economic center of the country. Serbia shares northern border with Hungary, northeast border with Bulgaria, south border with Macedonia, southwest border with Albania and Montenegro and the west border with Bosnia and Herzegovina and Croatia.

Zrenjanin

Zrenjanin is mentioned as the village risen on three islands of the river Begej. The Fortress was built later, and the location was populated by Serbs, Germans, Romanians, Italians, French and even Spaniards ("New Barcelona"). Great Bečkerek (Nagybecskerek), which is old name of the city, became an important trading center in 1769th. In 1807th the city was struck by a large fire. Since 1935th city gets new name – Petrovgrad, but changes it again after WWII so it eventually became Zrenjanin, since 1946th, after people's hero Žarko Zrenjanin Uča. During the WWII seven people's heroes from Zrenjanin have died in battle, and around ten thousand people were in camps and prisons and two and a half thousand were executed.

Zrenjanin represents administrative and transit center of Middle-Banat County, as of the municipality of the same name. In 2011th city had 79773 inhabitants, while the municipality had 132051 inhabitants. Zrenjanin is the largest city in Banat district, and third biggest in the province of Vojvodina, behind Novi Sad and Subotica. This town, often called Banat capitol, is located between two airports – "Nikola Tesla" in Belgrade (100 km) and "Traian Vuia" in Timisoara (110 km).

Zrenjanin is an important industrial center of Banat and Vojvodina. Textile, carpet, furniture, tobacco factories, building-industrial complex, all can be found in Zrenjanin. There is also shipyard on the river Begej, and the biggest of all – agricultural-food combine. Fishing is well developed on the river Begej and its channel. Resort "Rusanda" is located next to the village Melenci.

It is also important to mention some of very successful sportsmen and national representatives, that come from this town:

Dejan Bodiroga (basketball), Žarko Čabarkapa (basketball), Ivana Španović (long jump), Darko Kovačević (football)...
